

Sherwood High School Boosters Meeting
May 14, 2018

Financial Request

Zack Jenkins – High School Senior Football player – also representing Nic Garrison

- Nominated to play in Les Schwab Bowl
- Asking for support - \$250 each
 - o Total cost is \$500 each
 - o Fees cover food, lodging and team jersey
- Zack has already received donations from Wilsonville Toyota and have sold game tickets
- Boosters have paid \$250 fees for past football players invited to Les Schwab Bowl
 - o Other students have been invited to play but were committed to Division 1 schools which don't want players to play invitational games
 - o Board did not pay individual donation for a track player to go to an invitational in 2015
 - If we agree to pay for Les Schwab bowl invitational we will agree to pay same amount to all sports
- Board will purchase \$500 ad to support both players – decision unanimous
 - o Molly to contact Les Schwab organization to organize ad and payment
 - o Will find out if we can add 3 SHS cheerleaders who have been invited to cheer at game to ad
- Board going to decline two requests from Senaptec items
 - o Sensory Tablet Station and Strobe Glasses
 - o Travis Laioli is no longer athletic trainer

Jeff Scarvie – President

Stadium Overrun Balance

- Molly, Josh and Jeff meet with Eric Campbell re: the stadium-overrun bill
 - o Boosters agreed to pay \$819k with payments to made through 2025
 - o This original commitment (\$355) was paid in full by an anonymous donor in 2015 but the Boosters were still responsible for the overrun charges - \$215k
 - o Payment was to come from reserve seating fees
 - o We are losing 5 years of income because of moving to the new school in 2020 so a new total due of \$90k was agreed upon to be paid over the next 3 years
 - o There was supposed to have been an additional anonymous donor to pay the overage charges in 2015
- Question brought up - Why can't the city pay for the overage when they rent the old stadium out after the new school is built?
- Going to table discussion and decisions until more information can be gathered
 - o Bring in Mark Gribble, Bill Butterfield and Mark Erwin to next boosters meeting to review original arrangements
 - o Molly, Josh and Jeff will find past board members who dealt with the original agreement to better understanding of payment arrangements
- LRMS and SMS 8th graders are looking for apparel for end of year raffle
 - o Will donate 1 medium t-shirt to each school

Josh Munger – Vice President

- Josh and Kelly talked about raising prices for new purchasers of reserved stadium seats

- Grandfather the old price in (\$125) for returning seat holders
- Charge higher price (\$135?) for new reserved seat holders
- Should the board create an auction committee
 - Meetings would be separate
 - Members would include President or Vice President, Treasurer, Auction coordinator, 1 other board member and a member at large
 - Rent a storage unit for auction items
- Create a Social Media/Marketing position on the board to help with getting information into the social stream via Facebook, twitter, Instagram etc.
 - Kelly will work on ideas until decision is made about a permanent position
- Want to start collecting and recycling cans at stadium in the fall for all sports
 - Will set up a bottle drop account to deposit funds into directly
 - Will add signs informing public recycled funds go back to the boosters fund

Jason Upton – Member-at-Large

- Will donate Tennis tent to the apparel for the Robin Hood festival

Kristine Cornett – Auction Coordinator

- Auction scheduled for Saturday, November 11 at the Sherwood Elks
 - Generations will cater
 - Working with Elks to allow outside food
- Sheri Peden will assist Kristine this year and take over coordination next year
 - She would like another co-auctioneer moving forward

 - Molly will ask if he is going to stay with the basketball association if he takes over the boosters position
 - He will come to the June meeting for introductions

 - o They would like to sell at Friday night games next season
