- Will be selling pizza, pretzels, nacho's, popcorn in the concession stands non-perishable items
- Have secured several food vendors for the football season
 - Urzua will be selling Mexican, hamburgers, hotdogs at every game
 - Will tell them they can't sell sno cones
 - o Kona Ice is selling at every game
 - Don the Hotdog Guy has offered to sell but is only at 2 games
 - We'll tell him we don't need him this year maybe next year if he can sell at more games
 - O John Noffz will sell elephant ears at 3 games
 - Dutch Bro's will be at every game
 - Will have Kettle Korn at every game
 - Will receive 10% of sales from each vendor at each football game
 - Will split the vendor sales 60/40 with the football program
 - Will remain at 80/20 for sales from the concession stands
- Put Christmas lights by the Rotary area to light it up and draw people over

- Balance after August transfers \$55,363.94
- YTD Income \$41,683.39
- YTD Expenses \$47,181.97
 - Administrative expenses \$16,319.02
 - o Apparel expenses-\$1,530.10
 - Auction expenses \$0
 - Concession expenses 7,988.10
 - Team expenses \$21,364.75
- Would like to discuss moving to Quickbooks
 - Benefits include up to 5 board members can view at any time and not have to be shared
 - very transparent
 - Can limit view to read only
 - Currently using Google Docs
 - Cost is \$60/months 50% discount for the first 3 months
 - Easy to use for non-accountants
 - Jim is already familiar with software
- Jeff is going to confirm he has an old IPad and charger
 - Need to make sure it can handle the square
 - Need to see if we can increase the off line sales limit
 - Going to move the hot spot in the concessions to out from under the counter to see if the signal can reach the apparel trailer better
- Would like any paper emails scanned or take a picture and email and any electronic invoices should just be forwarded to Jim

 - Will try to have it installed before the first game

- Looking into different methods to notate reserved seats
 - Old plastic signs ripped clothes because of the square edges
