Coaches Requests

- Fisher – men’s and women’s swim team coach
 - o 4 years since last request
 - Purchased 32 warm up suits
 - o Expecting 40+ kids this season
 - o Would like to purchase 15 additional warmup suits
 - Don’t want or need to replace all – still in good condition
 - Total expected cost - \$1,293
 - o Would also like 10 additional aquatic backpacks
 - Total expected cost - \$403.50
 - o Board unanimously approved request
- Jeff Wilson – Head wrestling coach
 - o New rules allow new uniform
 - 2 pieces – shorts and tight fitting shirt
 - Will still use singlets but would like to ease in new uniforms
 - 55 sets - \$3,500
 - Weight Certification Scale
 - Needed to help manage proper weight loss for each wrestler
 - o Enters each students age, current weight etc. then a safe weekly weight loss amount is determined for that student
 - Need to have certification done each season
 - Current scale is 10-12 years old and has a crack, that could make it not likely to get certified this season
 - Only 1 OSAA approved scale can be used
 - \$1,999.99 – includes certification for the first year
 - o Board unanimously approved request

Josh Munger/Vice President,

- Adding lines to concession area helping manage crowds
 - o Might need to back them up away from the front to make exiting to the sides easier
- Hitting facilities for baseball/softball will be pre-built at new high school
- No lockers currently being planned under the bleachers of the new stadium
 - o Stadium will be fully enclosed with a solid wall surrounding field
 - o Space under stadium planned to be used for storage
 - o Concessions will be a separate building attached to the restrooms
 - o Randy going to see if apparel space could be attached to concessions as well
 - Possible have concessions and apparel share storage space

Kate Al-Sheikhly/Apparel

- Apparel sales going well
 - o Not going to re-order items that are sold out

- New logo planned for next season
- Will sell once a week at home basketball games in November/December
- If Sheri retires from the board Deborah Egler will step in
 - Will need a new board member to sell stadium seating next year
 - Could sell stadium seat through the apparel booth if necessary
- New labels on stadium seats are working well
 - No issues with people sitting in wrong seats
 - Some concern about the sharp edges snagging clothes so next year the edges could be rounded

Kristine Cornett/Auction

- November 11 – elks lodge – 6 pm
- Need to sell tickets and tables
 - 7 of 8 sold already
 - Might add a couple but they take a lot of room
 - Need all 10 names for table at once for check in
- Sign-up sheet will be sent out – only add name to volunteer tab
- Need auction items
 - Would like new items like vacation packages, Blazer games, etc.
- Hoping to get the same auctioneer as last year – Kevin Noreen
- Going to get more wine for the wine wall
- Team baskets need to be turned in by 10/31/17
- Kristine is planning on retiring so we need someone to take over her position
 - She will help train

Molly Zettlemyer/Treasurer

- Thank you from Southern Oregon for hosting their game
 - Donated \$500
 - Was specified to the "Football Boosters" but Coach Lawrence agreed to put it in the Boosters general fund
- Stadium seats
 - Last year we made \$20k – this year is currently at \$20,943
 - All scholarship checks have cleared
 - Bank balance as of 9/30/17 - \$98,204.66

Ryan Zettlemyer/Member at large

- Looked at security systems at Costco for concessions inside the high school
 - Need to tap into the wifi system at the high school
 - 4 cameras - \$299
 - 8 camera's - \$399
 - Might need to have Brad Buys (high school IT) help set them up because they are wired
- Board unanimously approved purchase for 4 camera system
- Ryan will help with the Drive 4 UR School fundraiser but is vacating the position after this coming year
 - Ryan will take it over from Colby
 - Will remove Colby as a Member at Large
