1. Break Out Sessions

- a. Auction
 - i. Location: Newberg Cultural Center
 - 1. Contract Not Signed, possibly no deposit

 - 1. Quote came in a bit high...around 12K
 - iv. Wild Bills-should be there as a draw
 - 1. Contract Signed
 - 2. Need to send a check for payment
 - v. Sponsorship- Allison Jedan will help with these duties
- b. Concessions
 - i. April 19th: Lacrosse "Civil War"
 - 1. All day youth event
 - 2. All fields being used and high school kids helping, should be used in concession stands so they can raise money
 - ii. Big wrestling tournament
 - 1. SOS call list for emergencies
 - 2. Learned a lot with how this event works and what food/drinks are needed
 - iii. Tax documents, receipts, register tape was taken from indoor concessions to football concessions. Needs to be gone through and dealt with (stored possibly)
 - iv. Acrylic "Concessions" sign (Crimson and white lettering) Would get mounted on wall adjacent to west gym entrance doors
- c. Apparel
 - i. Still selling apparel near concessions during inside sporting events.
 - 1. Ideas to spur spring sales
 - a. Baseball/Wrestling programs pre season apparel packages are bought by families
 - b. Basketball parents and fans don't seem to shop apparel as much as football

- c. Freshman orientation packages? When on February 24th 6:30-8:00 p.m. Bag with tshirt, hoodie, water bottle, stickers? Pull the trailer to the front of the school to get people going in.
 - d. Old Jerseys for basketball. Can we get them as a draw for Basketball fans/families? We get them for football. Kate Hartman?
 - e. Baseball- need to have apparel in the concessions stand, but need to get some baseball style shirts and more hats ordered.
 - f. Yard signs to celebrate athletes? Was done during COVID but not done anymore. Can we bring back and sell these? Could get pics of football players at Linfield camp. Sell \$25, try to purchase for \$10.
 - g. Storage location for backstock apparel so we can do larger orders and not lose out on sales. What storage locations are available?
 - h. Trailer re-wrap for 2026. PDX Wraps sponsor with logo.
 - i. Sweat pants as part of apparel offering.
 - j. Bang sticks, car window flags, pom poms
 - k. Stickers- engineering class Clark Farrand (engineering teacher) can we get stickers made.
 - l. Sell some kind of stadium seat for baseball bleachers. Seats are cold and uncomfortable.
- d. Scholarship
- i. Need a couple more reviewers for scholarship, Dave Griffin agreed to help.

- e. Stadium Seating
- i. Tim created a new stadium seat sales platform on Eventbrite. There is a commission charged per seat to the buyer.

 - 2. Do we want to change cost of seats (basic and premium)
 - 3. July 1st is when seating goes public for sale
 - 4. Do we want to comp tickets for coach families? They were not used by the families last year.
