Meeting call to order at: 6:05 PM

1. Approval of previous meeting minutes- Approved
2. Guests – None

3. Coach requests:

Unified Athletics - Coach Ken Kirby of Unified Athletics is requesting funding for uniforms for all 3 Unified sports and equipment. Total cost for equipment (12 basketballs and 2 soccer goals) for a request of \$1,029.70 (50%)

The Total cost for Unified sports jerseys (basketball, soccer and track) is \$3070.00 – they are requesting \$1,535.00 John motioned to approve the full \$3070 to cover the full amount of uniforms. Cami seconded the motion, the motion passed.

John motioned to approve the full amount of \$2059.40 for equipment and Cami seconded, the motion passed.

We will let Ken know that he has been approved for the full amount if that affects funding for the program, he can accept what is needed up to the total amount of \$5,129.40

Boys Soccer coach Martin Rakers is asking for new uniforms. The last ask was 3 years ago. The uniforms are passed down each year. Requesting uniforms for 27 kids-2 colors of shorts, 2 colors of jerseys for a total of \$5,200.00. Corey motioned to approve full funding, Joy seconds, and motion passes

4. Treasurers report- Jennifer stated that the cash balance as of 4/13/26 was \$127,418.35. Financially we are at about the same place we were in last year at this time.

5. Concessions Report – Tanel stated that the Need for speed event was a huge success and made \$7,400. Thank you to those that volunteered for concessions. Reminder, we need people to sign up to open and close concessions for spring sports. On April 25 we have a big track meet that needs lots of volunteers. This is an all-day event that requires 3 people to commitment to make this happen.

Richard had an update on branding for the concession tables. Richard is going to order the Bowman BBQ Crew Shirts – 4 shirts to be ordered for everyone and funding is taken care of.

6. Stadium Report – Cami stated we have 5 home games this year. She is proposing \$115 for premium seating and \$90 for regular seating (\$110 and \$90 last year). This price includes entrance and seats. Discount for seniors and booster club members available. May 21st is when registration will open to current ticket holders. July 6th registration will open up to general public. First game is on September 4th. The booster club made about \$7200 last year.

7. Apparel Report – Chad stated that he is putting order together to make a small test apparel order through Booster Hub. Chad would like to check out quality of the apparel before making a large purchase.

8. Scholarships – Joy stated no updates at this time. Still accepting scholarships applications.

9. Booster Hub – Jon stated the Board is looking at different platforms to streamline the work of the Booster club. The Board has been testing out Booster Hub. It is a platform that allows the Booster club to operate concessions, apparel, and finances. It has email but doesn't connect to social media

platforms. The Board discussed some limitations with concessions. There is a cost per concession I pad device. It would cost about \$1400 to switch over devices. It would be nice if volunteer sign-up sheets would integrate so if you are opening concessions, you can look and see who has signed up as a parent volunteer etc. Concessions financials don't integrate with system the way the Board would like. The Club has a 45-day trial to play around with it.

10. Social Media – Cori stated she will put the Booster club scholarship info on social media.

11. New Fundraising Ideas - Jon stated some of the top ideas for fundraising that were voted on by the Board are: A Golf tournament, Line Dancing/Parent night out, Super Bowl Squares, Alumni hall of fame dinner, 5K Race, and Kids dance. More ideas were discussed including a Meet the Bowman meet and greet with players and kids in the community. Jon stated the ideas to continue to work on will be a 5K, Meet the Bowman and Bowman brews and BBQ event.

12. Get to know your Booster Social Updates- Chad had no updates.
